You have enrolled in summer intensive class, MI30: *Perspectives on the World Christian Movement* course at Pittsburgh Theological Seminary for Term 1. This letter contains important information about this unique class, which is a joint effort of Pittsburgh Theological Seminary, World Mission Initiative, and the Perspectives Study Program.

Because this course is both a class at PTS and in the Perspectives Study Program, we ask that you register with both. Please go to [www.perspectives.org](http://www.perspectives.org), find the Summer Intensive class in Pittsburgh, and register online. Be sure to register as a graduate level student at PTS.

You will notice there is an additional \$75 charge to PTS Students. This covers the cost of your textbook and the administrative fee for the Perspectives Study Program. You may pay online with a credit card, or select “offline payment” and bring a check to the WMI Office, McNaugher 104. Please make checks payable to “Perspectives.”

**NOTE: The textbook is not available at Cokesbury.** Once you have paid the \$75 to Perspectives, you may pick up your books in the WMI office, McNaugher 104.

This will be an **intensive** course. We will be meeting for 42 hours of class time August 15-21. Attendance is mandatory. The class times are listed here. You are encouraged to also participate in optional lunch-time discussions and dinner outings with your classmates.

You will submit the answers to the review assignments and take-home exams online at [www.maperspectives.org](http://www.maperspectives.org). This allows a grader to give you feedback without the passing of papers over the summer months. Please log-in and create a more secure password by updating your profile.
