

# Frequently Asked Questions

## Perspectives Leaders' Intensive, August 15-21, 2010

### Pittsburgh Theological Seminary

#### What is Perspectives?

Perspectives is not so much a course, as it is a "movement" involving tens of thousands of God's people throughout the world finding their niche in God's overall purpose to bless the nations. Since its beginning in 1974, dozens of other seminars, courses, and materials have been developed after the pattern of the course. Perspectives is a program from the [U.S. Center for World Mission](#) and is taught worldwide. There are currently more than 70,000 alumni in North America alone!!!! #### How does the Leaders' Intensive version work?

- Classes are taught by a variety of dynamic speakers representing different backgrounds, education and experience. Class sessions are from 8:30 am-11:30 am, and 1:30pm-4:30 pm Monday-Saturday.
- Lectures are complemented by discussions, activities, and opportunities to discern implications for local congregations.
- Certificate, Undergraduate, & Graduate study levels available.
- After you register, you will receive a set of books and syllabus in the mail to begin your study. Required study through the first 5 lessons prior to the start of class. Completion of all readings, reviews & a project is extended to November 15, 2010 for those who wish to complete the certificate level.

#### Why does it cost \$325 + Room and Board?

This registration cost includes the textbooks and covers the cost for our instructors and activities.

#### Can I commute from the Pittsburgh Region?

Yes, you may drive in each day for the program. However, we do expect there to be a significant benefit for those who "come away" and stay on campus

#### Is there parking available?

Yes. The seminary has plenty of off-street parking for free.

#### What about arrangements for room and board?

Single room: \$50/night; Double room: \$70/night.

Breakfast and lunch are available on campus, cost \$5-7/meal.

Dinner at local restaurants with the class is an encouraged option (\$7-15).

#### What time should I plan to arrive?

Registration & room check-in begins at 5 pm, Sunday Aug. 15, with our first session beginning at 7 pm. If you are staying on campus, please arrive no later than 6 pm. Pittsburgh Theological Seminary is approximately 35 minutes from Pittsburgh International Airport (longer during rush hour).

#### What time should I plan to leave?

Although the class time ends at 4:30 on Saturday, August 21<sup>st</sup>, we are concluding with a celebration dinner on Saturday evening from 5-6:30 pm. We encourage you to stay through until Sunday morning and worship with us in Pittsburgh.
